

SIGNS OF **HEAT STROKE**



Heavy panting, difficulty breathing, excessive thirst



Bright red tongue and mucus membranes, which turn grey as shock sets in



Thick saliva, drooling, vomiting, and/or diarrhea



Unsteadiness and staggering



Lethargy



By the time signs of heat stroke are visible, it's often too late.
