CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT EDUARDO A. AUSMANN

CMSgt Eduardo A. Ausmann is the Senior Enlisted Leader of the 22d Medical Group, McConnell Air Force Base, Kansas. In this role, he serves as the advisor to the medical group commander on all issues regarding mission effectiveness, human relations, organizing, training, and equipping 276 medical personnel to deliver world-class care for 25,200 beneficiaries. He oversees a \$16.7 million annual operating budget, ensuring the delivery of safe, high-quality medical care while maintaining a high degree of medical readiness. He supports the 22d Air Refueling Wing, the largest refueling wing in the Air Mobility Command through expedited medical readiness of all operators of the KC-46 Pegasus and the KC-135 aircraft.

Before his current assignment, Chief Ausmann served as Inspector General of the 557th Weather Wing, Offutt Air Force Base, NE. He guided the Wing Commander on inspection policy, complaints resolution, organizational climate, and readiness. He evaluated the operational readiness of 1,400 Airmen and the compliance of 12 units, 19 GSUs, and contingency teams supporting 11 CCMDs worldwide, contributing to the effectiveness of \$567 billion in AF Weather Weapon Systems. Chief Ausmann has held various positions, including Senior Enlisted Leader, MAJCOM Functional Manager, and Bioenvironmental Engineering Instructor.



Chief Ausmann was born in Brazil and immigrated to the United States in 2002. He put to use his language and medical skills as an International Health Specialist, while deployed to Brazil and provided health care and humanitarian aid support to the local population during the Zika virus epidemic outbreak in 2016. He has deployed as a lead Bioenvironmental Engineering and Preventive Medicine subject matter expert and supported Operations IRAQI FREEDOM, ENDURING FREEDOM, TOMODACHI, INHERIT RESOLVE, ALLIES REFUGE, and SPARTAN SHIELD.
