COLONEL SHAWN M. "MOSHE" MOSHER

Col. Shawn Mosher is the Deputy Commander of the 931st Air Refueling Wing, McConnell Air Force Base, Kansas. The wing reports to 4th Air Force, March Air Reserve Base, California, and is an Air Force Reserve KC-46A Pegasus associate unit working alongside the 22nd Air Refueling Wing at McConnell AFB. In conjunction with the 22nd ARW, the 931st ARW supports Air Mobility Command's worldwide air refueling mission, meeting the air refueling needs of all U.S. Air Force, Navy, Marine and selected allied nations' aircraft. In addition, they supplement AMC's strategic airlift capability. Furthermore, members of the 931st ARW are engaged in a cross section of combat support services for all U.S. military branches in times of peace, war and national emergency within the United States and abroad.

Col. Mosher was commissioned in 2003 through the United States Air Force Academy. He is a Command Pilot with multiple assignments flying the C-21, KC-10, and KC-46 aircraft, including tours at the squadron, group, and wing levels in AMC, AETC, and AFRC. His previous assignment was the 514th AMW Chief of Current Operations overseeing the flying schedule which consisted of three major weapon systems (McDonnell Douglas KC-10 Extender, Boeing C-17 Globemaster III, Boeing KC-46 Pegasus) and 500 reserve aircrew members.

Col. Mosher has deployed six times commanding combat and combat support missions in support of operations ENDURING FREEDOM, IRAQI FREEDOM, NEW DAWN, and COMBINED JOINT TASK FORCE HORN of AFRICA.

Colonel Mosher is a Command Pilot with more than 3900 military flight hours.
