The BWI USO provides baggage storage between the hours of 0600L-2200L with room permitting. Bags must be claimed by 2145L or they will be turned over to the Maryland Transportation Authority Police. (NO WEAPONS STORAGE)

S/A INFO: Vehicles must be parked, rental cars returned, and all luggage must be available prior to Space Available call. Anyone that arrives after no later than time to be marked present posted on our 72-hour schedule will be considered late and placed at the bottom of ALL categories. There is an \$22.90 head tax charged per passenger, credit card payment only. All documentation must be checked prior to Space Available call to ensure travel eligibility. All children age 14 and older require a dependent I.D. card to be travel eligible.

Passengers are authorized to check two pieces of baggage not to exceed 70 pounds each (140 pounds total) and 62 linear inches (the sum of the length plus the width plus the height). Single items exceeding 70 pounds and/or 62 linear inches shall be counted as two pieces and, therefore, fulfill the allowance for a passenger. If aircraft space is available, Space-R passengers may purchase space for personal excess baggage. Space-A passengers are not authorized excess baggage. EXCEPTIONS: A3, B-4, duffle, and sea bags shall be allowed as one piece up to 80 linear inches as long as they do not exceed 100 pounds. The same applies to large garment bags, golf clubs, surfboards, snow skis, bicycles, fishing equipment, rucksacks, and/or musical instruments. Snow skis, bicycles, and fishing equipment should be properly packed to avoid injury to baggage handlers or damage to other baggage. Only one of these bags per person shall be the allowed exception. The second bag must still comply with size restrictions and is limited to 70 pounds. ***BAGGAGE EXCEEDING 80 LINEAR INCHES/100 POUNDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Disposition of unauthorized weight or oversized baggage is the responsibility of the owner/traveler and he/she will have the option to acquire boxes or purchase luggage on the local economy to meet the authorized weight/dimensions. ***

All TSA Guidelines are followed by Air Mobility Command at BWI.
