## PATRIOT EXPRESS BAGGAGE POLIGY

## Checked Baggage Allowance:

Each passenger is authorized two pieces of checked baggage not to exceed 70 pounds and 62 linear inches (sum of length +width height), each. Bags heavier than 70 pounds or larger than 62 linear inches will be counted as two pieces and an excess baggage fee may apply. Excess baggage rates vary but will not exceed $\$ 125$ per piece. Baggage exceeding 80 linear inches and/or 100 pounds WILL NOT be accepted. Excess Baggage is Not Authorized for Space-Available Passengers.

## Carry-on Baggage:

Each passenger is permitted to hand-carry one article (e.g., small luggage, garment bag, backpack) and one personal item (e.g., cosmetic case, purse, small box, package) for storage in the passenger overhead bin compartments or under the seat in front of you. Approximate size should not exceed 9 " x 14 " x 22 " for a total of 45 linear inches.

## Authorized Excess Baggage:

When authorized by Military Service regulations, an individual's orders may include an excess baggage allowance, stated by number of pieces and not by weight. If excess baggage authorized is not listed within the travel orders, passenger(s) will be charged excess baggage fees.

Unauthorized Excess Baggage: Baggage that exceeds the normal allowance without proper authorization may be accepted for shipment at the discretion of a passenger service representative, subject to the capacity of the mission to support excess baggage. When baggage in excess of that capacity is refused for transportation, the owner is responsible for disposition of unauthorized baggage not accepted for shipment.

## Excess Baggage fee: \$125 per piece.
