SUBJECT: OUSD (A&S) Lifts All Restrictions on Space-A Travel Associated with COVID-19

PURPOSE: Inform terminals of OUSD (A&S)'s lifting of Space-A Travel restrictions effective immediately.

BACKGROUND: In March 2021, OUSD (A&S) reissued guidance limiting Space-A travel due to the continuing spread of the 2019 Novel Coronavirus with limitations to remain in effect until a determination was made to safely remove these limitations.

POLICY: On 22 April 2022, OUSD (A&S) issued the attached memorandum to the Services and USTRANSCOM reinstating all Space-Available Travel Program Categories as defined in Department of Defense Instruction 4515.13, "Air Transportation Eligibility," Change 6.

Units and passenger terminals will start accepting eligible Space-A travelers effective immediately. Units should continue to train, conduct mock processing events, and adjust seat releases as determined by terminal leadership to build capability. Units and passenger terminals will take necessary actions based on assessment of their capabilities to restore full servicing by 13 May 2022.
