**MANDATORY FACE COVERING POLICY IAW  
USTRANSCOM/AMC guidance dated 09 Dec 2020 the  
following is required for ALL passengers**



- All passengers in USTRANSCOM/AMC passenger terminals and while utilizing military or commercially contracted aircraft **MUST** wear face coverings when personnel cannot social distance (Minimum of 6 feet). The use a masks with exhalation valves or vents is **PROHIBITED**. (IAW CDC GUIDANCE)
- USTRANSCOM/AMC will **NOT** provide face coverings. Cloth face covering shall extend above nose without interfering with eyewear, and below the chin to cover mouth. It shall fit snug but comfortable against the sides of the face and be secured.
- Passengers who disregard this policy are at risk of being removed from their flight.

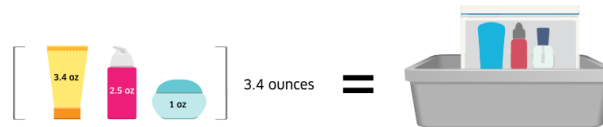

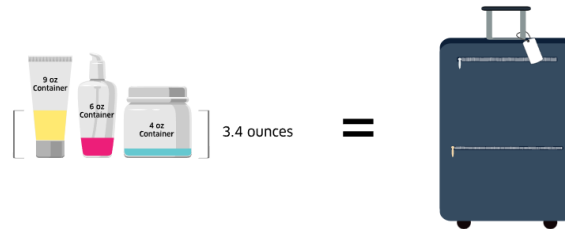
## Carry-On Bag

3.4 ounces (100 ml) or smaller sized containers that fit in 1 quart-sized, resealable bag may go in carry-on and through checkpoint security.



## Checked Bag

Containers that are larger than 3.4 ounces (100ml) regardless of amount inside must be in checked baggage.

# SPACE A (Unofficial Travel) Passenger Information

## Covid 19 Entry Requirements for the USA



Passenger terminals will perform primary health screening for all passengers. If passengers fail primary screening, they will not be allowed to travel unless cleared by a medical authority via letter or via secondary screening completed by a medical authority.

Negative Covid tests are no longer required to travel to the USA. For Covid vaccination requirements:

US Citizens, US Nationals and Lawful Permanent Residents (Green Card Holders) are not required to be fully vaccinated. The CDC recommends non vaccinated passengers self-isolate for 5 days on arrival in the USA then get tested.

All other passengers are required to be fully vaccinated\*\* and maintain documentation on their person during travel and will present this (digital or hardcopy) on request.

\*\*Definition: Fully Vaccinated means there has been 2 clear weeks since the last dose in the course of injections, be it the single dose or multi dose variants. Fully vaccinated does not include the booster. If you have the booster, the means you are Up To Date as well as being Fully Vaccinated.

Non US citizens and Non US Nationals are required to complete Attestation paperwork. This does not apply to Lawful Permanent Residents (Green Card Holders).

**ALL** passengers (US Citizens and Foreign Nationals) under 18 are exempt from being fully vaccinated.
