



****TRAVELING TO: JAPAN****

INBOUND PASSENGERS WHO ARE NOT ON SOFA STATUS WILL REQUIRE AN ENTRY STAMP FROM THE JAPANESE OFF BASE IMMIGRATIONS OFFICE. A BOARDING PASS IS REQUIRED UPON ARRIVAL TO THE IMMIGRATIONS OFFICE TO RECEIVE AN ENTRY STAMP.

PER THE DOD FOREIGN CLEARANCE GUIDE, "TRAVELERS PLANNING TO PERFORM UNOFFICIAL (PERSONAL) TRAVEL DURING OR IN CONJUNCTION WITH THEIR OFFICIAL OVERSEAS ASSIGNMENTS, SHOULD OBTAIN (AT THEIR OWN EXPENSE) A REGULAR (BLUE TOURIST) PASSPORT PRIOR TO DEPARTURE FROM THE CONUS."

AS OF 6 JULY 2023, DOD PERSONNEL MUST HAVE A "REGULAR (BLUE TOURIST) PASSPORT" TO ENTER JAPAN WHILE ON LEAVE (OR OTHER UNOFFICIAL TRAVEL STATUS)

PER DOD FOREIGN CLEARANCE GUIDE SECTION 1.B.1. HOWEVER, US MILITARY PERSONNEL ON LEAVE RETURNING TO THEIR UNIT OF ASSIGNMENT IN JAPAN MAY TRAVEL ON MILITARY ID CARD AND TRAVEL ORDERS." REGULAR (BLUE TOURIST) PASSPORT IS STILL REQUIRED FOR CIVILIAN PERSONNEL RETURNING TO JAPAN.

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****Space-A Process for Early Bird Roll Calls on Patriot Express****



- Roll Calls for Patriot Express missions may be held at 1200L the day prior to the scheduled flight departure if there are 20 or more available seats.
- Passengers will be able to sign up for Space-A and compete for roll call if their authorized leave date begins on the day of departure prior to normal Roll Call time.
- **If traveling in a group, all passengers must be present for Early Bird Roll Call.**
- Selected passengers are eligible to check their bags and receive a boarding pass during the Early Bird check-in period(times advertised below on the 72-hour Schedule)
- Passengers not selected due to seat availability will have another opportunity to compete at the normal roll call time (advertised below on the 72-hour Schedule). Passengers will then be able to compete for open seats in the event of no shows.

****Note: Passengers that come in on Space-R status take priority over passengers on Space-A status. Passengers on Space-A status can be subject to removal from the flight on the day of departure for Space-R passengers, beginning with the last selected passenger.****

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PATRIOT EXPRESS EARLY-BIRD CHECK-IN TRAVELERS IN PCS/TDY STATUS



Check-In Information

- Early-Bird Check-In for the Patriot Express flights will begin 24 hours PRIOR to Estimated Time Departure (ETD). It is HIGHLY recommended that all passenger's check-in early.
- PCS/TDY personnel MUST have a copy of their orders for the passenger terminal to utilize as well as IDs for active-duty personnel and passports or ID cards for dependents of age 14+ at the time of check-in. Passengers will not be considered travel ready if they lack any of the aforementioned requirements.

Please Note

You MUST bring all bags and pets (inside carriers) to be checked-in and receive your boarding pass.

Pets, carriers and carry-on items will not be held overnight

WARNINGS

•TRANSPORTATION OF FIREARMS AND INSPECTION OF CHECKED BAGGAGE

FAA REGULATIONS REQUIRE THAT FIREARMS IN CHECKED BAGGAGE MUST BE DECLARED ,UNLOADED AND IN A LOCKED CONTAINER. PASSENGERS FAILING TO DECLARE FIREARMS OR TRASPORTING LOADED FIREARMS ARE SUBJECT TO CIVIL PENALTY OF \$25,000.

PASSENGERS REFUSING TO PRESENT IDENTIFICATION AND. OR PERMIT CHECKED BAGGAGE INSPECTION MAY NOT BE TRANSPORTED.

•CARRIAGE OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

THERE ARE SPECIAL EXPECTATIONS FOR SMALL QUANTITIES OF LIQUIDS, GELS, OR AEROSOLS, THREE OUNCES PER CONTAINER, PACKED IN A ONE QUART ZIP-CLOSURE BAG. E-CIGARETTE SMOKING MATERIALS ARE ALSO PERMITTED IN HAND CARRIED BAGGAGE..

•TRANSPORTATION OF NARCOTICS

FEDERAL LAW PROHIBITS THE TRANSFER, USE OR POSSESSION OF

NARCOTICS INCLUDING MARIJUANA, ABOARD AIRCRAFT.

INFORMATION

•CHECKED BAGGAGE LIMITATIONS

PASSENGERS ARE ENTITLED TO TWO PIECES OF CHECKED BAGGAGE NOT TO EXCEED 70LBS. EACH FOR A TOTAL OF 140LBS. NEITHER WILL EXCEED 62 LINEAR INCHES(LENGTH+WIDTH+HEIGHT).

•IDENTIFICATION OF CHECKED BAGGAGE

GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS REQUIRE THAT NO PASSENGER'S BAGGAGE BE CHECKED FOR TRANSPORTATION UNLESS THE PASSENGER'S NAME IS ON THE OUTSIDE OF SUCH BAGGAGE.

•CARRY-ON BAGGAGE LIMITATIONS

FAA REGULATIONS REQUIRE THAT CARRY-ON BAGGAGE BE LIMITED TO ITEMS THAT CAN BE CONVENIENTLY STOWED UNDER YOUR SEAT OR IN AN APPROVED STORAGE COMPARTMENT. ITEMS WHICH CANNOT MEET THIS REQUIREMENT MUST BE CHECKED AS REGULAR BAGGAGE.

NOTICE TO PASSENGER

Emergency Restrictions / Prohibition Order Of the United States Department of Transportation
