MR. GREG BLUETHMANN

Mr. Greg “Blue” Bluethmann is the Air Mobility Command Public Affairs Chief of Civic Engagements, Headquarters Air Mobility Command, Scott Air Force Base, Ill. In this role, he advises and supports the Public Affairs Director, AMC commander and staff, on community engagement initiatives to foster the command’s relationship with local communities at all AMC installations. Mr. Bluethmann also serves as the key advisor to AMC installation Public Affairs offices on their community relations programs to build advocacy for their Airmen, families, and mission.



Prior to his role as AMC public affairs Chief of Civic Engagements, Mr. Bluethmann previously served as the Chief Enlisted Manager for Air Mobility Command public affairs where he was responsible for organizing, training, and equipping 226 enlisted public affairs professionals serving in 19 different organizations across the country. Additionally, he oversaw and advised on the development and employment of 27 officers and 49 civilian public affairs professionals. His expertise was key to resolving a 5-year gap to meet public affairs staffing requirements for multiple senior executives. Mr. Bluethmann skillfully negotiated position exchanges with other organizations to ensure an equitable allocation of employees, satisfying stakeholders’ desires for robust public communication capabilities.

Mr. Bluethmann entered public affairs in 2004 when he retrained from a communications maintenance background into the radio and television broadcasting career field. He has held assignments throughout his career at American Forces Network (AFN), Combat Camera, and wing and MAJCOM public affairs offices. Mr. Bluethmann served on five combat deployments in support of Operation Southern Watch, Operation Iraqi Freedom, Combined Joint Task Force – Horn of Africa, Operation Enduring Freedom, and Operation Inherent Resolve.
