


FACE COVERING REQUIREMENTS

Travelers must have face coverings to enter terminals and on military and commercial aircraft. Passengers must bring their own coverings, as they will not be provided.



Face coverings must be worn in the terminals and in flight any time a distance of six feet between travelers cannot be maintained.

Coverings shall extend above the nose and below the chin to cover the mouth and nose completely.



Coverings should fit snugly but comfortably against the sides of the face.

Terminals will deny travel to passengers without appropriate face coverings. The CDC does not recommend face coverings be placed on children under the age of two.



Balaclavas, neck gaiters, T-shirts, purchased and homemade masks are acceptable.
