He was responsible for managing the contractor support of the KC-46 Tanker aircraft fleet; which entailed: spares management, repair processing, spare inventory and warehouse management, support equipment management, field service technical support, aircraft maintenance support, aircraft discrepancy reporting, quality assurance of parts, aircraft metrics reporting, and Aircraft On-Ground (AOG) remediation. The Boeing McConnell AFB warehouse is the hub for aircraft spare parts management and as such provides spares support to other KC-46 bases. He was responsible to brief senior USAF commanders and senior Boeing directors on a regular basis.

Prior to this, Jerry led the Finishing Center activities for the KC-46A Tanker with responsibilities that included: leading the Manufacturing and Quality elements for the USAF KC-X Tanker proposal; relocation of the Finishing Center and Boom Assembly from Wichita to Seattle; and then ultimately to Everett, and the Boom assembly and Finishing Center aircraft installations.
