### BRIGADIER GENERAL NICHOLAS EVANS

Brig. Gen. Nicholas Evans is the Vice Superintendent, U.S. Air Force Academy, Colorado Springs, Colorado. As Vice Superintendent, he is the principal coordinating agent for all command matters, and he supports the Superintendent in directing a four-year regimen of military training, academics, and athletics, leading to a Bachelor of Science degree and a commission as a second lieutenant in the U.S. Air Force or U.S. Space Force.

Brig. Gen. Evans received his commission from the U.S. Air Force Academy in 1999. He is a command pilot with over 2,500 hours in the F-16 and F-35, and he is a graduate of the USAF's F-16 Weapons Instructor Course. He has commanded at the squadron, group, air operations center, and wing levels – all in the Indo-Pacific theater – and his notable staff and joint assignments include Executive Assistant to the Commander, Pacific Air Forces, and Director of the Commander's Action Group for U.S. Indo-Pacific Command. In 2017, he completed a Doctor of Philosophy in Military Strategy through the Air Force's School of Advanced Air and Space Studies.
